For 24 hours, strict regulations are enforced, collectively known as "Catur Brata Penyepian," which forbid travel, work, fire or lights, pleasure, and entertainment activities across the island. 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### **Ogoh-Ogoh Parade Watching**

The Pengembungan village's procession of Ogoh-Ogoh Parade (massive monster puppet) are carried through the streets accompanied by traditional music.
