Waterfall Tour Course

There are many large and small waterfalls in this area. Participation in the "Waterfalls Guided Walk" is recommended.

Moss Observation Course

The most recommended course for enjoying the small mossy forest of Oirase Gorge. Participation in the "Moss Trail" is recommended.

Mainstream Course

The most recommended course for first-time explorers. By using the Keiryu Shuttle Bus, you can easily visit the representative landmarks. Participation in the "Keiryu Guided Walk" is recommended.

Stream Exploring Etiquette

In Oirase Gorge, the collection of natural objects (including fallen leaves and branches) is strictly prohibited. Also, to protect the vegetation, try not to stray too far from the walking paths.
