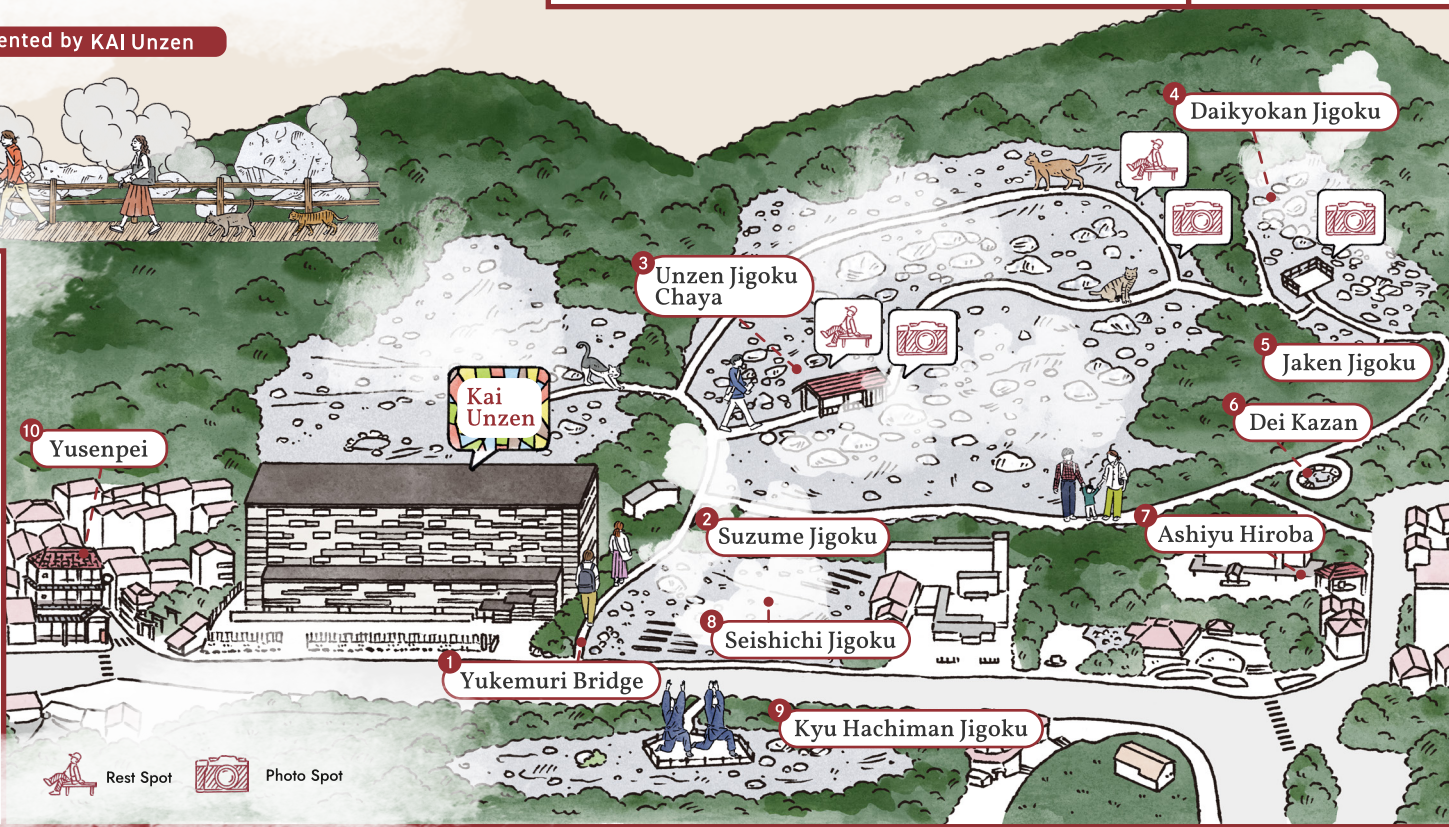


# Unzen Jigoku Power Charge Map

**1 Yukemuri Bridge**  
Yukemuri Bridge is the typical entrance to Unzen Jigoku. You can feel the steam overflowing from the gap of the bridge with your whole body.

POWER CHARGE 10%

**2 Suzume Jigoku**  
Jigoku that sounds like sparrows chirping. You can feel the energy of the small earth.

POWER CHARGE 20%

**3 Unzen Jigoku Chaya**  
The center of Unzen Jigoku. There is also the Unzen Jigoku Kobo that sells "Onsen Tamago" steamed in the hot spring, so it is recommended to take a break while walking.

POWER CHARGE 30%

**4 Daikyokan Jigoku**  
It is the most fumarolic hell in Unzen Jigoku. The hot water that spews out reaches nearly 100°C and is marked by a 30-40 m white steam.

POWER CHARGE 40%

**10 Yusenpei**  
Totoumiya Honpo is a long-established store of yusenpei that carefully selects the hot spring water that gushes out, makes the dough by craftsmen, and finishes it by hand baking techniques. After relaxing in the hot spring, please enjoy Yusenpei as a souvenir.

POWER CHARGE 100%

**9 Kyu Hachiman Jigoku**  
This Jigoku is no longer active. When you touch the stone pavement in the square, it is warm and warm due to the geothermal heat, and you can feel the power of the earth.

POWER CHARGE 90%

**8 Seishichi Jigoku**  
You can see the hot water supply system "Kantsuke" that uses geothermal energy from jigoku. It is an eco-cycle that helps hot water supply in KAI Unzen!

POWER CHARGE 80%

**7 Ashiyu Hiroba**  
It is a free foot bath in Shinyu area. It is located near Unzen Jigoku, so it is recommended to relieve the fatigue of your legs while walking.

POWER CHARGE 70%

**6 Dei Kazan**  
Dei Kazan is similar to conical volcanoes formed by blowing mud from the ground. That's why it was named Dei Kazan which means mud volcano.

POWER CHARGE 60%

**5 Jaken Jigoku**  
The name comes from a legend that when jealousy (Jaken) arises, drinking this gushing water will relieve it.
